HERAKLION, CRETE: GLOBAL GATHERING

For the celebration of the 35th anniversary since the founding of ISFNK, numerous heads of chapters of the Society representing Argentina, Belgium, Canada, China, the United States, France, Greece, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Switzerland, and Tunisia gathered in Heraklion on August 2, 3, 4, and 5, 2023.

Together they explored the entire island of Crete, visiting archaeological sites, the Nikos Kazantzakis Museum, and the offices of the Greek Chapter of the ISFNK. Subsequently, they attended an official event at the Kazantzakis Museum, featuring the screening of an interview with George Stasinakis which took place at his residence in Geneva, and his nomination as an honorary member of the Museum's Board of Directors. The introduction was delivered by our friend Stelios Matzapetakis,

former Member of Parliament and honorary president of the Museum. Honors were also bestowed upon Stavros Arnaoutakis, Regional Prefect of Crete, and Varvara Tsaka, former Director of the Kazantzakis Museum.

The musical segment featured the Cretan Folk Opera by Manos Mountakis inspired by Nikos Kazantzakis *Odyssey: A Modern Sequel.* It was a superb performance attended by a large audience. Katerina Zografistou, member of the Coordinating Committee of the ISFNK and President of the Greek Chapter, presented him with a Collector's edition of the epic.

The hall was filled with people, during the final part of the meeting, moderated by Nikos Skenteris, a member of the Coordinating Committee and 2nd Vice President of our Greek Chapter. Initially, representatives from various chapters presented the activities of their ISFNK's chapter in their respective countries. The audience was enthused by the significance and quality of these presentations. Nikos Chrysos, 1st Vice President of the Greek Chapter, introduced George Stasinakis' book titled: Paths of Life - In the Footsteps of Nikos Kazantzakis 1989-2019, featuring a foreword by Peter Bien, one of the most prolific scholars of our author's work (Kapa Editions, Athens, 2020). Katerina Zografistou delivered a speech titled "Kazantzakis and the Youth". Finally, Pantelis Voutsas, an artist from Komotini, Greece, crafted a wooden sculpture portrait of Kazantzakis and gifted it to George Stasinakis. Special distinctions were awarded to schools in Heraklion and to the Local Administration of Heraklion of the International Police Association. Awards were presented to the winners of the international competition in secondary education schools (see below). The award ceremony was preceded by a presentation of the competition by Vanda Papaioannou-Voutsa, a member of the Coordinating Committee and the Board of Directors of the Greek Chapter. We warmly thank all those friends who traveled from four continents, Katerina Zografistou, Sofia Ntalampeki, special Consultant to the Coordinating Committee for technical and electronic means of communication, and Maria Zachariaki, Treasurer of the Greece Branch of ISFNK, for their impeccable organization and execution of these unforgettable days.

ISFNK INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS

We have already mentioned in "SYNTHESIS" the significance we assign to promoting the work of Nikos Kazantzakis among the youth through the organization of exhibitions, lectures, screenings, and competitions. The participation and quality of the entries in this year's competition exceeded our expectations.

Participation: 204 students from 49 schools in Albania, Armenia, Belgium, Greece, and Uzbekistan.

Written Works: Prose: 41 (38 in Greek, 2 in French, 1 in English), Poetry: 55 (50 in Greek and 5 in French), Painting: 108.

Winners

Poetry: Michael Magafosis, Anavryta Gymnasium, Athens. Title of the poem: "The Traveler of Words" (in French).

Prose: Thaddée Meurant, French Lyceum Jean Monnet, Brussels. Title: "I Have Not Yet Finished My *Odyssey*" (in French).

Painting: Maria-Penelope Paspatis, General Lyceum of Mytilene, University of the Aegean.

The ISFNK offered this trip to the winners, who were accompanied by their parents.

The ISFNK plans to publish all of the students' work (96 literary works and 108 paintings).

Athens, June 10-11, 2023: "Nikos Kazantzakis and His Greek Contemporaries: Interactions, Affinities, Disagreements."

The list of speakers was published in "SYNTHESIS," issue No. 61, of April 2023. It was organized by Nikos Chrysos in collaboration with Dioptra Publications. The event was held under the auspices of the Ministry of Culture, the Hellenic Authors' Society, the French Institute of Greece (IFA), and the Municipality of Athens, with the support of Kastaniotis Publications, Niki Stavrou (The Nikos Kazantzakis Estate), and the electronic magazine "Xápτης." Thessaloniki, November 25 and 26, 2023: "Kazantzakis and Global Intellectuals."

CULTURAL ROUTES ''KAZANTZAKIS-ZORBAS''

In June 2022, the ISFNK published *Cultural Routes: Kazantzakis (1883-1957) - Zorbas (1865-1941)*. The network of sites-landmarks in Greece, the Caucasus, and North Macedonia of two free spirited men." It includes our initiatives and those of other organizations in honor of the two friends. The publication was warmly received.

The Greek Ministry of Culture has recommended that we submit a formal letter to the Council of Europe, requesting the inclusion of the aforementioned cultural routes, along with the ISFNK for all its endeavors and accomplishments, in the Cultural Routes Program.

Furthermore, we were informed by Alexandra Gouta's article in the Athens-Macedonian News Agency of July 2023 that the Mayors of Velvento and Aristoteli are planning specific development initiatives for Katafygi, Zorbas' birthplace, as well as for Paleochori, where Zorbas resided for two decades.

In conclusion, a pilgrimage to Zorbas' tomb in Skopje is scheduled for November 24, 2023. Those interested in

Argentina, Buenos Aires, University, School of Philosophy, December 2023: Kazantzakis's Theatrical Works.

Australia, Three lectures were organized by the Melbourne Chapter, president of which is Giannis Milidis: On June 21, 2023, Professor Vrasidas Karalis, of the University of Sydney, presented his lecture on 'Saviors of God - Spiritual Exercises'; On July 4, 2023, Professor Giorgos Kechagioglou delivered a lecture titled: 'Nature in Kazantzakis's Journeys'; On August 9, 2023, Professor Alfred Vincent, University of Sydney, delivered a speech titled: "Nikos Kazantzakis and his Connections with France." In collaboration with the University and the Association of Greek Students, the local Sydney Chapter, headed by Vasilis Adrachtas, will organize a roundtable discussion on November 8, 2023, titled "Kazantzakis's Enigma: Author, Poet, Philosopher, or Theologian?" The participants will include Alfred Vincent, Maria Zarimi, and Vasilis Adrachtas. The event will feature a screening of Menios Karagiannis' documentary titled '33,333: The Odyssey of Nikos Kazantzakis'.

Austria, Salzburg Festival, August 13-27, 2023: Four performances of Bohuslav Martinů's opera "The Greek Passion," inspired by Nikos Kazantzakis' Christ Recrucified. University of Vienna, September 11-14, 2023: European Congress of Modern Greek Studies: university scholars from Greece, Poland, and Latvia will explore various facets of the work of the great Cretan author.

Canada, *Toronto*, *September-October* 2023: Voula Vetsi, president of the local chapter, informed us that her team will organize two meetings to discuss the proceedings of the conference "Kazantzakis and Greek Authors" which was held on *June 10-11, 2023*, in Athens.

Greece, *Heraklion*, *Municipality*, *May 31*, 2023: Lecture by Katerina Zografistou, titled "*Friendship and Animosity in the Fictional Works of Nikos Kazantzakis.*" *Hydra*, *Festival*, *July-August 2023*: Organized by the Historical Archive-Museum of Hydra in collaboration with the Nikos Kazantzakis Museum, featuring Niki Stavrou, the intellectual heir of Kazantzakis, with the support of the ISFNK. It featured an remarkable exhibition designed by Niki Stavrou titled "Nikos Kazantzakis, 140 Years of Light" (with manuscripts and items from the life of Nikos and Eleni Kazantzakis). Katerina Zografistou explained the significance of the word "Light", which holds a special place in our author's oeuvre, its global impact, and the efforts of the ISFNK, which has been steadily promoting it across five continents for the past 35 years. We wholeheartedly congratulate the directors of the Historical Archive-Museum of Hydra and the Kazantzakis Museum, Dina Adamopoulou and Marilena Miliathianaki respectively, Niki Stavrou, Katerina Zografistou, and our representatives from the "Modern Greek Studies Foundation" in California. *Thessaloniki, October 18, 2023*: Lecture by Elena Avramidou on Kazantzakis' unpublished novel, *The Ascent.*

Japan, Meisei University, Hino (near Tokyo), August 5, 2023: Screening of the film by Jules Dassin, "He Who Must Die," inspired by *Christ Recrucified*. A discussion will follow. Our congratulations to Kosuke Fukuda, a member of the Coordinating Committee, and to his team for their outstanding efforts to keep the work of Nikos Kazantzakis alive in Japan.

United Kingdom, Queens' College, Cambridge, June 30 - July 1, 2023: Conference on the Centennial Celebration of Saviors of God – Spiritual Exercises. The ISFNK was represented by Professors Vasileios Groen (Austria) and Giannis Sakkas (Greece).

Switzerland, Geneva, November 30, 2023: To celebrate the 35th anniversary of the ISFNK, the Chapter will host a symposium dedicated to the epic poem *The Odyssey: A Modern Sequel.* Rozmi Pahlisch Tzanou, Chapter President, will present the epic poem, while actors Ann-Lise Fritz and Michel Kuhn will recite excerpts, accompanied by saxophonist Raphael Daniel. The event is held under the auspices of the Municipalities of Geneva and Heraklion, and the Consulate General of Greece in Geneva.

A TEXT BY NIKOS KAZANTZAKIS

"Kazantzakis - Sipriòt. Conversations", Éditions du Rocher du Rocher, Monaco, 1990 (excerpt).

I remember two succinct lines from a poet whose name escapes me: "While we were fighting, Nature was welcoming Spring." I sense, behind the tragic fate of the contemporary human, Nature, beautiful and eternal, remaining utterly indifferent to our fleeting tragedies. Anxiety overwhelms us; we dim, feeling more than ever the need to open a window to glimpse, in the brief moment of a flash, the sky, the stars, the sea, spring; suddenly, though, the window closes, and we find ourselves once again facing the demons of darkness that besiege us. To cast a brief and intense gaze upon nature, amidst the cries of struggle and anguish, becomes, increasingly, I believe, a necessary escape to a lost paradise. Yet, this glance must be very brief, for we no longer have the time to linger in detailed descriptions.
